Last Week's Program: David Sideri introduced **Christina Farabell** and **Jessica Johansen**, physician liaisons from **Cyber-Knife Centers of Tampa Bay** for Program Chairman **Dr Pal Nanda**. Kevin Mayeski, the CyberKnife Administrator, could not attend as he had an emergency. They spoke a bit about the CyberKnife system that it is a painless radiation treatment that can be an alternative to open surgery in many cases. It allows for precise delivery of radiation so that higher doses can be used. The CyberKnife System is based on radiation technology that has been in use and well proven for more than 30 years. It uses image-guided robotics to precisely destroy tumors and other lesions which spares normal healthy tissue, while the higher dosage offers improved chances for cure. This procedure is covered by Medicare and most insurance providers. 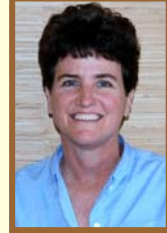

This Week's Program: Program Chairperson, Christine Patel will be introducing **Capt David Olson**, U.S. Navy (Ret), Founder and Program Executive Director of the non-profit Combat Wounded Veteran Challenge program. David was born in Pensacola and now lives in Palm Harbor, Florida, with his wife of 29 years, Teresa. They have three boys and one daughter, two of whom currently serve in the military. David attended the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, Class of 1979, and commissioned a Navy Ensign. He coached sailing at the Naval Academy before reporting to flight school in Pensacola in the fall of 1979. He was designated a Naval Aviator in 1981. David entered the Navy Reserve in 1987, served as Commanding Officer of two Naval Aviation Systems Command reserve units and then re-activated in September of 2001. They completed several assignments and deployments, the last of which was Operation ENDURING FREEDOM and Operation IRAQI FREEDOM while assigned to U.S. Central Command, where he retired as a Navy Captain (2009) and subsequently retired from the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) in 2012. He founded SCUBAnauts International in 2001, a marine sciences program that introduces young men and women, ages 12-18, to informal science education through underwater exploration. In 2010, David founded the non-profit Combat Wounded Veteran Challenge program, to improve the lives of our wounded and injured Veterans through rehabilitative, high-adventure challenges, and therapeutic outdoor recreational activities while conducting scientific research to speed their recovery and that of their families. David also serves as a Naval Academy Blue and Gold Officer, providing admissions guidance to high school candidates interested in pursuing a degree from the U.S. Naval Academy with a commission as an officer in the Navy or Marine Corps. He also serves on both Florida Senator Bill Nelson's and Congressman Gus Bilirakis' Naval Academy nomination screening boards.
