It's better to get members engaged than to lose them, as replacing 1 lost member equals the effort & cost to retain 5 members. The three drivers of engagement are: Satisfaction with immediate leaders; Belief in senior leadership; Pride in the organization. Why is engagement important? Highly engaged clubs outperform by 202% and fully engaged members have about an 89% retention rate. The triangle of success is: Skills, Attitude & Knowledge.
