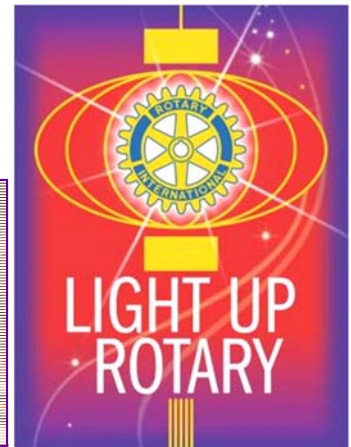

Last Week's Program: **Truly Nolan Pest Control**

Mark Sparks, manager of the Truly Nolan Pest Control for Pinellas County spoke to us about Truly Nolan. In 1938 Mr. Truly Nolan started his family owned company here in Florida and in 1957 he expanded in Arizona. Truly Nolan now has 100 branches in the U.S. and 130 International Franchises, worldwide.

They have the iconic yellow mouse car – we have all seen it! Mr. Nolan is also a huge antique car fan and has an antique car in front of many of their offices. The company, Truly Nolan has what they call “Good Citizen” events on a monthly basis. The theme for August is the Dog Days of Summer. Mark’s branch is donating their time at an animal shelter.

The company is a full service pest control with unique proprietary equipment, one being the Tornado machine for termites. Another service they offer is the lawn service, killing weeds, taking care of diseases & fertilizes the lawn.

For Pest control they have what’s called the 4 Seasons Approach – they treat seasonally (quarterly) for the specific insects of that season and generally will only come into the home to treat only once during the winter season.

Insulation –Truly Nolan Insulation Plus is made with 87.5% recycled newsprint and treated with 12.5% Borates. It is Energy-Star certified and blown in for a custom installation and they can increase the "R" factor for your home. Borates are naturally occurring minerals that kill insects. It exists in trace amounts in rock, soil, water and all living things. Consequently, they have marginal environmental impact.

The company has 12 core values that they are very serious about. They take a lot of pride in what they do and do the best that they can.
