Program Chairperson, **Susan Walker's** program will be an informative session on the City of Pinellas Park's Neighborhood Services Department (Code Enforcement) and the services that they provide for the Citizens of Pinellas Park.



### **Last Week's Program:**

**John Gluck** presented us with a program on **S.A.F.E. (Secure All Firearms Effectively)**. He had a display of different revolvers & rifles explaining the importance of having an owner's weapon manual. Apparently, revolvers are all different as to how to load them and they do not have a built in safety lock. John showed us several ways that you can lock them for child safety, two of these were cable locks & a box with a combo lock. Besides keeping your family safe from misuse of your weapon, if a 15 year old or younger is able to take a gun outside and is caught with it, the owner of that gun will go to jail. John does not like a "trigger lock" .... It can still go off with a little wiggle work. In regards to a rifle, 18" is the shortest length, by law. He said to use bird shot so it will only hit a wall in a cone shape, whereas other ammo can go through MANY walls. There are over 51,000 registered weapons in Pinellas County.
