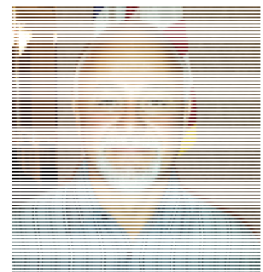

Last Week's Program:

Program Chairperson **Wendy Sideri** introduced **Corporal Daniel Butterworth** and **MJ Sherman**, who are partners in the *Homeless Outreach Team*, as our guest speakers. **Corp Butterworth** started talking about



how to recognize homelessness. The Homeless are not just single men living on the street. They are the people frequenting soup kitchens, people & families living in vehicles, those moving from apt to apt and those living in Pinellas Hope's Tent City. The definition of homeless is

"no permanent stable housing". Florida is ranked #2 in the nation for homeless people, possibly because we have the year-round environment along with the best facilities to take care of the homeless. There are more than 59,000 homeless kids & in Pinellas County, we have the most homeless veterans in the U.S. One in Four homeless persons served in the military. Some of the causes for homelessness are financial problems/economy, alcoholism, mental health, domestic violence, physical disability and substance abuse.

The "Outreach Street Team" is a partnership of Law Enforcement & Social Workers. The team approach works best because together they become approachable. Because they are a team with different abilities, they have a broader understanding of the problems, they have the resources to access for assistance, they can build rapport, and they have the safety of having a trained law enforcement officer.

Next Week's Program: Program Chairman **Kenny Krauss** will introduce **Barb Bennett**, Program manager of Group Home #1 at Carlton Manor #1. Carlton Manor is a non-profit agency that consists of 2 residential group homes that aid severely emotionally disturbed boys aging from 6 to 17 years of age.
