The Game was created in Dec 1979 and released in 1982. Its popularity peaked in 1984 with 20 million games sold that year.



In 1993, *Trivial Pursuit* was named to the "Games

Hall of Fame"

In 2003, an on-line version of the game was launched.

By 2004, nearly 88 million games had been sold in 26 countries & 17 languages.

In 2008, Hasbro bought the rights to the game for \$80 million.
