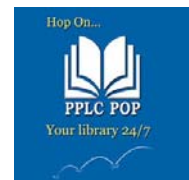
BOWL-A-THON - APRIL 16, 2016

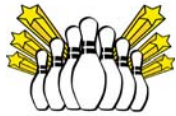

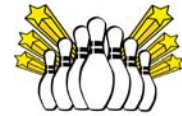
