Christine Patel – Happy and Proud to see her daughter, Alex, graduate from UF Law school.

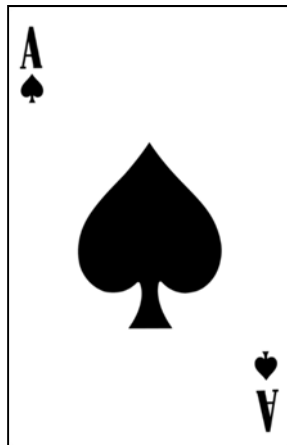
Jerry Krauss – Way to go Alex! Happy also that the Lasagna is prepared and ready for the party this Saturday night.
