The Rotary Club of Fairborn, Ohio, has sold more than 100,000 children's books that teach Rotary's Four-Way Test. *Andy & Elmer's Apple Dumpling Adventure*, a picture book with an accompanying coloring and activity book, includes stories centered on concepts including good citizenship, following directions, and teamwork. The initiative has become the prime fundraiser for the club's service projects, as more than 300 clubs in the U.S and beyond have bought the book for distribution in primary schools and local libraries, says club member Dottie Meade, who launched the literacy project a decade ago. This Week's Program: Program Chairperson **Tami Scheele** will introduce **Carrie Root**. Carrie has been a Rotarian and member of the RC of Tarpon Springs since November 2011. She has been the District 6950 Foundation Scholarship Chair for the past three years. Her classification is Engineering Consultant. Carrie resides in Tarpon Springs Florida. Her program will be about the different scholarships offered through Rotary International and the district.



Last Week's Program: Program Chairperson **Colleen Carson** introduced her mother, **Judy Gates**. Judy talked about bee keeping and the community benefits of bees. Judy shared some of her information with us last year and she went into great detail on various matters pertaining to bees. Some interesting matters were: In collecting pollen, bees collect about half their body weight each trip. All the bees in the hive are female. An average hive collects about 100 pounds of pollen in a season. In a colony of Bees, there are about 40,000 bees all working for one boss, the Queen. Drones live 25 days, stay in the hive a few days, then leave to join the bee cloud for the single purpose of mating with queens. Workers live 40 to 50 days and have various tasks. Foragers go from sunrise to sunset in a 5mile radius, making 10 trips a day, each lasting about an hour, collecting nectar, water, pollen and propolis. There are additional bee workers called Nurse bees, Cleaner bees, Builder bees, Temperature control bees, Guard bees and Undertaker Bees.
