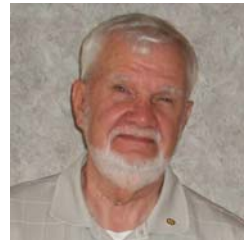

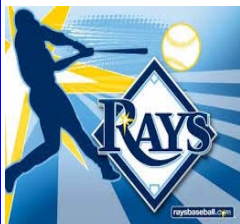
Last Week's Program:

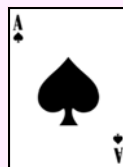
