As a native of Pinellas County and graduate of St. Petersburg High School, Eric and his wife, Tracy, are raising their children with the same local values -- Service, Sacrifice and Family — that he grew up with here. Eric is running for the open Florida State House seat representing Pinellas Park and St Petersburg in Tallahassee. Eric graduated from Northwestern University and Georgetown Law school where he earned his degree while working on Capitol Hill. As a young lawyer and policy advisor, Eric was honored to serve as one of the first 50 people to work for President Barack Obama in his historic campaign for the presidency in 2007-08. After the campaign, Eric was appointed to serve as a Senior Advisor in the Pentagon, advising three Secretaries of Defense over six years of service.

Last Week's Program: Program Chairman *Bill Ashcraft* introduced retired *Lt. Colonel Bruce Silvey*. He is a former Aviator for the U. S. Army, the Executive Vice President of the Army Otter Caribou Association, and is a member of the St. Petersburg Bowling Hall of Fame. Bruce's wife is from Gayal, Peru. His Father served as a Second Lieutenant in the Army and, in 1955, was a member of the Rotary Club in Shawnee, Oklahoma. Bruce showed photos of his first car, a 1939 Packard, as well as photos of many famous planes and helicopters..... such as the



Bird Dog L-19, the U6-A Beaver, the U. S. Army Otter, the U. S. Army Caribou and the CH-47 Chinook transport helicopter. Bruce provided some history and background regarding the creation of the Air Force and the U. S. Army Airborne Division. Bruce served two tours of duty in Vietnam, one was in 1965 in Pleiku, South Vietnam with the 173rd Airborne Brigade as a decorated pilot. Bruce also received a Bronze Star. His message for us was to remember those who served our country. At the conclusion of his talk, he received a standing ovation from all our members.

Dr. Pal Nanda honored his birthday by donating \$91.00 to our Pinellas Park Rotary Club Foundation. We all stood and sang "Happy Birthday" to him in our best singing voices.
