Eric graduated from Northwestern University and Georgetown Law school where he earned his degree while working on Capitol Hill. As a young lawyer and policy advisor, Eric was honored to serve as one of the first 50 people to work for President Barack Obama in his historic campaign for the presidency in 2007-08. After the campaign, Eric was appointed to serve as a Senior Advisor in the Pentagon, advising three Secretaries of Defense over six years of service.
