Last Week's Program: Program Chairmen *Joe Minarik* and *Richard Breske* outlined the Pinellas Park Rotary Club's involvement with The Rotary Foundation, the Paul Harris Fellow Lottery and the Polio Plus Partners program. The Club provided a 2016-2017 District Grant to the Pavilion at Lurie Park / Wounded Warriors Ability Ranch. The Club has also collected donations of \$7,800 through the Paul Harris Lottery. Club Member Harry Alchin was congratulated for becoming a Paul Harris Fellow, and seeks for both of his parents to also become Paul Harris Fellows. The Club has also donated \$3,000 to the Polio Plus Partners program and has received an additional \$3,000 in benefactor donations, bringing total donations to \$13,840. Forms were distributed explaining how a member could donate. Both The Rotary Foundation and the Polio Plus Partners program are 501 (c)(3) charities with the IRS, with all deductions being tax deductible. The Rotary Foundation is over 100 years old.
