Dr. Linda S. Plunkett, Ph.D., is the wife of Rotary member **Jim Plunkett** and a former member of the *Jacksonville Rotary Club*. She is a Christian Psychologist who has operated *Hope for the Hurting*, a non-profit 501(c)(3) ministry for over 15 years. On 12/14/2012, she had brain surgery. The infamous school massacre in Connecticut occurred while she was undergoing an 8 hour surgery to remove a tennis ball sized non-malignant tumor. Following her recovery, she has authored a book called "Supernatural Rescue: From Broken to Beautiful." The book details her feelings of physical brokenness, spiritual abandonment and the subsequent shutting down of her ministry, followed by a supernatural rescue leading to her recovery and the reopening of her ministry. President **Yvonne Fay** introduced **Juliet Kyes**, who works with her parent's family business, **Action Coach**. She is described as a Business Action Coach, specializing in Time Management. She divided Time Management into three categories: 1. "**Important, but not Urgent**" includes relationships, learning and reading, exercise & family. 2. "**Not Important, but Urgent**" includes cell phone, computer interruptions and people interruptions. 3. "**Not Important, Not Urgent.**" category includes things as Entertainment, Facebook & Twitter and elective activities. Juliet also described the "**Above and Below the Line**" concept, using **Blame, Excuses, and Denial (BED)** as statements for below the line that should be avoided and **Ownership, Accountability and Responsibility (OAR)** for above the line that should be embraced and actively sought. The family has authored a book titled, "**OMG – WTF - What's The Focus?**"

Kevin Krauss: Is happy that the renovations (new floor and ceilings so far) at *Seminole Lanes* are going well.

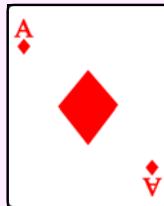
Janet Waddell: She and **Mike** are celebrating 50 years as a couple. They started dating the second week in October, 1966.
