Our Rotary Bowl-A-Thon

Last Week's Program: Program Chairman **Ken Bray** introduced **Dick Crippen**, Executive Director of Community Development and the "voice" of the *Tampa Bay Rays* baseball club. **Dick** also heads up the *Rays of Hope Foundation*, a charitable organization that benefits many under-privileged people. He was named the *Florida Sportscaster of the Year* four times in the 1990's. Dick and his wife just celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. He expressed optimism for the upcoming season, touting the recent signing of Gold Glove Center Fielder **Kevin Kiermaier**, and the new playing turf at *Tropicana Field*. He mentioned his friendship with Hall of Famer **Wade Boggs**, who spent 6 years in the minor leagues before making it to the majors. Dick explained that



minor league players travel on buses and commercial airlines and receive only \$35 per diem expenses, which is in sharp contrast to the minimum major league salary of \$500,000.00. The Rays have over 200 employees, including 18 full-time scouts. They are the only team in Baseball that has 9 minor league teams. The Rays also run a Baseball training academy in Venezuela and one in the Dominican Republic.
