Rotary Serving Humanity

Last Week's Program: Program Chairperson Janet Waddell introduced Kristina Fortner, the Executive Director of *Girls Inc.* Kristina provided information about the afterschool and summer programs that they provide. Her organization has been around since the Civil War era, originally affiliated with the Boys Club of America and was called Girls Club of America. Some of the major issues and unique challenges that young girls face are: 16% do not finish high school, nationally 30% of girls become pregnant before the age of 20, locally even



higher at 33%, 78% of girls under the age of 17 are not happy with their body shape, and some are victims of sexual abuse. The Girls, Inc. program teaches life skills, provides academic assistance, and lets the girls participate in many activities. They have a 4,000 square foot playground, a library, computer lab, art area and kitchen facilities. Their girls have a 97% high school graduation rate. There are currently 190 girls enrolled in the Pinellas County program, plus 6 interns. Although considered as a small non-profit, Girls Inc. has a budget of \$40,000 per month.
