In addition to his parents, the only other survivors were one grandparent, an aunt, and an uncle. Subsequent to his father's liberation from Dachau and his mother's liberation from Auschwitz, Harry was born in a Displaced Persons Camp in Southern Germany. Harry is a member of the Lutz Rotary Club and a former member of the Hyde Park Rotary Club. He has served District 6890 in various District and Club positions, including being the Team Leader for a Group Study Exchange to Australia in 2006. Harry has served many years on the Board of Directors of the Florida Holocaust Museum (FHM), Hillsborough Achievement Resources Center and is a graduate of Leadership Hillsborough. He is a Docent and a Speaker at the FHM and regularly presents information about the history of the Holocaust .

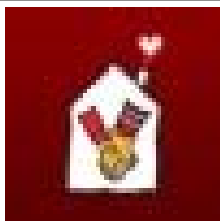

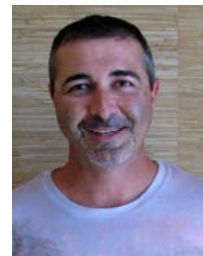
