World Roundup: Rotary Projects from Around the Globe

India: The Rotary Club of Poona spent \$30,000. on a new, specially equipped van that makes rounds to collect breast milk that, after pasteurization it will be given to newborn babies in need. This should help to reduce neonatal mortality.

Rwanda: The Rotary Club of Scottsdale Sunrise in Arizona has led a \$63,500. global grant, teaming with Project Cure, to arrange the delivery of about \$1.5 million in high quality donated medical gear to southern Rwanda. The life expectancy in Rwanda has doubled to 60 years of age over the past two decades.
