Last Week's Program:

Program Chairman **Don Higgins** introduced **Beth Maday**, the Executive Director of the Bardmor YMCA. Her topic was "**Wellness programs for all ages.**"

She introduced Branch Council Member **Heidi Akers** to assist her with the presentation. We were told the story of "*the two Maddies*," one a 93 year old courageous cancer patient, and the other a 5 year old child being raised by her Father's sister, who started in the YMCA scholarship program at the age of 2. Although these people have diverse backgrounds, the "Y" has helped both of them. The "Y" was started in London, England as part of a Bible Study, which branched out into other areas to help change the lives of young people living in London. The "Y" came to the Boston area of the U.S. in 1851, and was instrumental in the creation of Basketball, Volleyball and Father's Day. The "Y" is in 119 countries, has 600,000 volunteers and awards \$100,000 per year in scholarships. The Bardmoor "Y" had 88 children on scholarship at this past year's summer camp. About 14% of the participants are on some form of Scholarship.

Rotarian **Starlyn Fikkert** enjoyed her trip to the Alligator Attraction at Johns Pass with exchange student **Marie Hacker**. Seeing a live Alligator was one of the events on Marie's Bucket List while studying here in America during this school year at Dixie Hollins H.S. They learned that Alligators hatch all at the same time once per year. They live to be 35 to



50 years in the wild and 65 to 85 in captivity. A small, two year old alligator has the same "bite force" as a large dog. They watched kids feed the baby alligators hot dogs with a fishing pole. Pinellas Park Rotary's Halloween "Trick or Treat Trail"

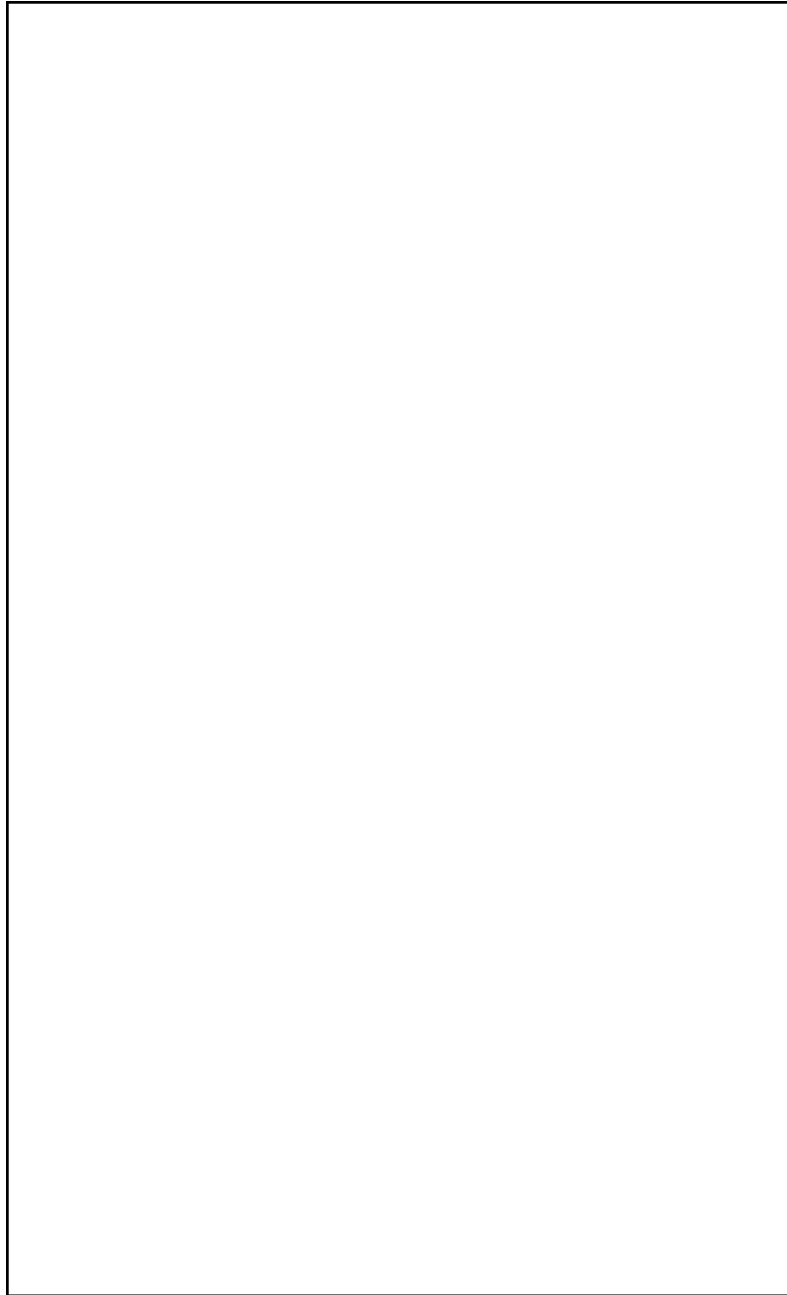
