He teaches the complete RVIA curriculum along with supplemental materials for hands-on training along with extensive classroom instruction. Students receive RV Tech Training Center's certificates and diplomas, and also have the



option of testing for the RVDA/RVIA registered test and the RVDA/RVIA certified test. RV Tech Training Center is licensed by the Commission for Independent Education, State of Florida Department of Education. It is an approved vendor for VA and CareerSource funding. Sam is a RVTC and RVDA/RVIA Master Certified RV Technician and Instructor. He is also Universal EPA certified in Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, and has two certifications from Florida LP Gas.
