Program Chairman **David Allen** presented a detailed description of the types of work and service that his family owned company, Allen Industries, performs.



Allen Industries is a large company which has 6 manufacturing facilities located in Phoenix, Arizona; Detroit, Michigan; Toledo, Ohio; Clearwater, Florida; Greensboro, North Carolina (HQ); and High Point, North Carolina. The company has 450 employees and uses over 3,000 sub contractors worldwide.

The 87 year old company, which is ranked in the top 10 in the U.S., designs, manufactures, builds and installs signs, canopies, and awnings for companies around the world. Some of the major clients are Mack Truck, Arby's, Hardees, Church's Chicken, Lowes, Checkers, Wells Fargo, Red Lobster, John Deere, Dairy Queen, Burger King, Volvo, SOL Petroleum, Total Petroleum, Speedway, and Family Dollar. The company has a dedicated International Project Team that is able to provide rapid response to hurricanes and other disasters.
