Program Chairperson **Yvonne Fay** introduced **Michael Debreezy**, who is the Chairman for *Camelot Community Care*, a mental health organization that has been serving children and families experiencing abuse, neglect, behavioral health and substance abuse issues in Pinellas County for over 30 years. The organization is dedicated to “bringing families together for a bright future,” by stopping the cycle of abuse and neglect in families and in our community by addressing behavioral health and child welfare. Over 600 families were served in Pinellas County by the program in 2017-2018. They also offer an independent program to support youth who are no longer eligible for Foster Care as a result of age. Statistically, A child is 10 times more likely to be abused in a biological family setting than in Foster Care. Camelot operates a specialized Foster Care program that ensures that all of the Foster parents in the program are highly trained in helping children heal from abuse or neglect.
