Last Week's Program:

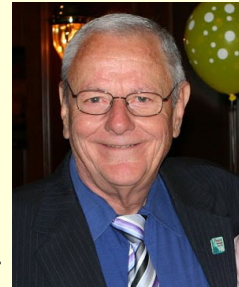
Covering for Program Chairman **Jimmy Hammond** last week, **Kenny Krauss** introduced **Brian Ellis**, who is with the Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council. The Council is a local planning agency, covers six counties and 21 cities / municipalities, of which Pinellas County is a member.

Brian presented a program on the topic of hurricane preparedness and recovery for small businesses. His hope is to bring information to us on continuity practices and some post-disaster tips that can help prepare small businesses for when disaster strikes. He stated that all businesses should have a disaster plan in place by establishing a single point of contact and evacuation planning. Businesses should also build resilience backups for critical supply items. Some businesses may even share inventory during shortages.
